### Wednesday Night Prayer Walk

Last night was an awesome night as we saw the power of God’s Holy Spirit visit the student commons and the streets of Dixie Drive, Buena Vista and Moline. As you are aware we divided the 17 students into six teams and had 13 adults to serve as team leaders. We dropped the teams off, 3 teams on Deleon and 3 teams on Reveille. They were to walk, pray and place prayer cards on the door handles of each home (225). Then the teams would meet in the middle of the street and circle for prayer after they completed their mission.

Here is just a sample of happenings along the way:

- One team was able to encounter a woman who needed prayer and prayed with she and her son.
- Another team was able to meet a woman who just moved into the neighborhood with a young child. She said she wanted to attend Park Place.
- Some also encountered Spanish speaking people. In the little Spanish that they knew, they communicated to the people that they were from Park Place and were out praying for the neighborhood.
- Some students also experienced people telling them to go away both in English and Spanish. Others without even knowing what the youth were handing out, tells them they don’t want to buy anything.

What we know is that a team of prayer warriors from UBA and Mission Houston had already prayed over our students that day. We had prayer warriors back at the church praying as the teams were out in the neighborhood.

After arriving back at the church the students were so “**pumped**” they were going “**crazy**” telling of their experiences. They want to do this again and are eager to serve the Lord in this manner. There is a great song that I just heard, “**Wake Up the World**” that I want to let you check it out.

- All through the world Your light burns bright, and through my soul You’re shining, and in my heart, **Lord**, take control; **And** now You’ve changed me through and through; **I’ll walk my streets**, Lord, shouting You, You made me new, You made me new.
